SWIATVELVET.PL SITE PRIVACY POLICY

This document entitled "Swiatvelvet.pl Site Privacy Policy" provides information about basic threats related to the use of the swiatvelvet.pl site, hereinafter referred to as the Site, and about the principles of Internet data collection by the company operating under the name of Velvet CARE sp. z o.o. with its registered office in Klucze, Klucze-Osada 3, 32-310 Klucze, hereinafter referred to as Velvet CARE.

1. Cookie Policy.

In order to ensure the best possible operation and to enable efficient use of the Site, we use files called "cookies". Use of our site means that they will be placed on site user's end device, i.e. computer, laptop, mobile phone, tablet, etc.

Cookies do not cause any configuration changes on the device or software installed on the end device of the Site user.

We use cookies for the following purposes:

- to customize the content of the Site to the individual user's preferences, most of all these files make it possible to recognize the user's end device in order to properly display the site customized to the user's preferences (cookies are only associated with the browser on a particular device, without the user's first or last name - anonymous user),
- 2) to prepare statistics that help us learn how users use the Site, which makes it possible to improve its structure and content,
- 3)in order to forward them to our trusted partners for marketing purposes, including behavioural advertising, i.e. advertisements adjusted to preferences of the users,
- 4) to ensure security of the Site.

In most web browsers you can: delete cookies from your computer's hard drive (from your browser settings level), block all transferred cookies and set an alert before they are saved on your drive.

However, please note that changes to these file settings, i.e. restricting their use, may affect certain functions available on the Site. If you do not change these settings, you accept our use of cookies.
